



Qualifications for CMDA Student/Resident Mission Funding

1. Participant must be a born again Christian believer with a clear personal knowledge of Jesus Christ as his or her Savior and Lord
2. Mission should be a medical outreach that has **Great Commission** of Jesus Christ as a primary purpose (preferred), or the mission should consider evangelism of Jesus Christ as an openly acceptable activity.
3. CMDA has the expectation that the student/resident
 - a. Is a member of CMDA
 - b. Has regular involvement with a CMDA Mentor who can recommend the student/resident. Student/resident should provide the name of their mentor. **If the student does not have a regular mentor, they should establish a mentor specifically for the trip. The student should meet with their mentor before and after the trip for discussion, accountability, and encouragement.**
 - c. Has active church participation. Student/resident should provide the name of their pastor or small group leader.
4. CMDA holds the expectation that the student/resident will participate in the medical evangelistic outreach under Christian leadership, authority and mentorship. Student/resident should describe how that will occur.
5. The student/resident will be expected to participate in a format/program that allows opportunity to share the gospel. The student/resident should be able to describe these anticipated opportunities.
6. The student/resident will be expected to describe how they will minister physically, emotionally, spiritually to the people with whom they are working.
7. What are the spiritual fruits anticipated from this outreach? How will the student benefit? How will the kingdom benefit?
8. Other information that will be requested
 - a. What is the purpose of the trip?
 - b. Where are you going?
 - c. When is the trip?
 - d. How long is the trip?
 - e. Who is sponsoring this outreach?
 - f. What is the cost of this trip?
 - g. Is this an individual outreach or will the student/resident participate in a group?
 - h. Has the student participated in other mission endeavors? If so, what were the fruits of those activities?
 - i. What percent of your time will be spent in Christian outreach?
